Jupiter will enter Cancer on June 9, 2025, at 9:02 PM UTC, and will remain there until June 30, 2026, at 5:52 AM UTC.

We are also likely to see the expansion of emotional intelligence: Jupiter in Cancer urges collective and personal growth through deeper understanding of emotions and inner worlds. This is also a time when blessings are best received through gentleness, rest, and alignment with lunar rhythms.



Jupiter in 4th House

TAURUS SUN

Jupiter in 3rd House

GEMINI SUN

Jupiter in 2nd House

Themes: Values, money, self-worth.

CANCER SUN

Jupiter in 1st House
