

Saturn – planet of discipline, responsibility, and structure – shifts from sensitive Pisces into fiery Aries on May 24 giving us a taste of Saturn lessons to come.

The planet Saturn moves through the Zodiac every 29 years, spending approximately 3 years in each Sign. Saturn moves into Aries in May and Retrogrades into Pisces on September 1 before finally moving into Aries from February 14, 2026 where he stays until February 13, 2028.



Jupiter in 4th House
