

Makemake in your BIRTHCHART

In recent years, dwarf planets have quietly been finding their place in modern astrology, particularly in countries where new planetary energies are welcomed into astrological practice. While once overlooked, these distant celestial bodies are now seen by many astrologers as powerful symbols of collective transformation and awakening. From Europe to South America and Australasia, Makemake, Haumea, and other dwarf planets are beginning to influence astrological charts and interpretations, offering new layers of meaning that speak to our evolving relationship with the cosmos. In 2005, the night sky got a little more interesting with the discovery of a new dwarf planet: Makemake, named after the Rapu Nui creation god of Easter Island

In Rapa Nui mythology, Makemake is the principal creator god, the one who brought life into existence. He is said to have created humanity, animals, and plants, shaping the natural order of the world. On Easter Island, he was also closely tied to fertility, seasonal cycles, and the abundance of resources like birds, fish, and crops.



Astrologers see the planet Makemake as renewal, creative energy, innovation, and a responsibility to care for the environment. Just as the Rapa Nui honoured Makemake through rituals that emphasised survival, abundance, and balance with nature, the planet named after him symbolises a call to higher consciousness. Makemake in your birth chart reminds you that true creativity and progress come from harmony with the natural world.

Dwarf planet expert Alan Clay notes that the discovery of Makemake, along with other distant dwarf planets, aligns with a period of expanding human awareness and collective evolution. Makemake was found in the far reaches of the Kuiper Belt, well beyond Neptune's orbit, in a region populated by icy, primordial worlds. This celestial body takes approximately 305 to 306 years to complete a single orbit around the Sun, moving slowly through the zodiac and spending about 25 years in each sign.

Because of this gradual journey, Makemake's influence is less about personal day-to-day shifts and more about shaping entire generations. Its energy is often associated with creativity, ecological wisdom, and a deepening respect for the natural world, themes that resonate strongly with humanity's growing awareness of environmental interconnection. MakeMake in 1st House
